REGISTRATION

Registration is available online at www.americanquiltstudygroup.org

On-site registration is not available for the AQSG Seminar.

Registration is limited to 200.

The full Seminar registration fee of \$410 includes the Thursday evening welcome reception, six meals from the Friday evening opening banquet through Sunday closing lunch, all program costs, the keynote address, nine paper presentations, invited lunch speakers, show and tell, poster session, research workshop, panel presentations, and on-site quilt exhibit.

Partial registration is available for Friday evening-only.

No registrations will be accepted after July 15, 2021.

On-site registration will be available for open slots in Study Centers only.
