AQSG will again hold a poster session at the 2021 Annual Seminar, where members can present their quilt-related research to fellow Seminar participants.

A poster presentation is a focused display of a research question, literature review, research methods, and results.

The AQSG poster session hosts multiple research presentations at the same time, and encourages conversation between presenter and audience in a relaxed, salon format. For many academic disciplines, poster sessions are an important conference component as many people can share their research in one time slot with interested attendees.

To be considered for the Poster Presentation Session, submit an Abstract by **February 1, 2021** to [Jodi.evans@iowa.gov](mailto:Jodi.evans@iowa.gov)

Abstracts are 200-word “research snapshots” that describe briefly the research being undertaken.

Abstracts will be reviewed and selected by members of the Publications Committee in a double blind process (both submitters’ and reviewers’ names will be kept confidential from one another).

The amount of space available at the Seminar venue may affect the number of abstracts accepted.

Participants prepare a display consisting of a large poster or various sheets of information that can be pin-mounted onto a standing display board. Presenters may also have a PowerPoint slide show or videos on their laptop, collections of pertinent items, and handouts.

Presenters are responsible for constructing the poster, including providing a standing display board if required, transporting it to and from Seminar, and setting up and taking down posters before and after the 2-hour session. Presenters are expected to be present to discuss their posters with interested audience members.
